2. Two (2) Pioneer CDJ-2000s linked via Ethernet (No Exceptions)

3. One (1) SL4 Serato unit + space for laptop (Must be setup and fully working before artist performance)

4. One (1) Shure SM58 Microphone or similar, connected via the mixer

5. Two (2) Monitor Speakers – Mackie SRM- 450 or similar, adjustable through mixer

Additional Rider and booth setup instructions:

- **1.** The DJ Booth must be equipped with at least two 15" format monitors in good working order in close proximity to the booth. Artist's must have control of monitor volume.
- 2. All units noted above must have the proper wiring.
- 3. (Monitors **must** be connected to monitor level control on DJ mixer, and positioned facing **away** from the dancefloor!)

Security:

The well being of Artist's equipment is the promoter's responsibility when Artist's is not present. Promoter is responsible for the security of the equipment and assigning security guards to prevent theft or tampering.

Sound check:

A sound check is *not always* necessary if the show has been advanced and cleared, however, in situations where clarification is necessary a brief sound check before doors open may be required.

Hospitality:

The following must be provided to the ARTIST, free of charge-

- One (1) bottle of premium Vodka
- One (1) Large bottle of Sprite or Lemonade
- Six (6) bottles of mineral water
- ONE (1) face / hand towel
- Dressing room or green room w/ internet access, if available
- Dinner / good local cuisine or \$50 hot meal per diem (per gig day)

- 3.5 star hotel (or higher) w FREE WiFi / internet + complimentary breakfast



Other Requirements:

- 1. Lights, monitors and PA must be provided, setup and broken down by promoter.
- **2.** Transportation to and from airport & Venue must be provided. If the promoter is unable to provide transportation, adequate cab fare, including tip, will be provided by promoter.
- **3.** A dressing room with a private bathroom should be provided at venue
- **4.** If the venue is outdoors, a trailer or RV must be provided.
